



Grant Submission Guidelines

The Desert Hospital Auxiliary, a nonprofit organization at Desert Regional Medical Center, offers grants of up to \$10,000 to IRS-certified secular nonprofits in the Coachella Valley. We prioritize local organizations that both raise and utilize resources within their communities.

To qualify your proposal must meet these criteria:

- Must address wellness needs of underserved people in the local community, including but not limited to medical care, nutrition, and interim shelter.
- Must only fund direct program expenses—activities specifically tied to the program.
- May not be used for overhead costs like salaries, rent, or utilities.
- Must provide effectiveness measurements and reports to the Auxiliary.

You will need the following information to complete the application process:

- Organization name
- Contact information (address, phone, email, etc.)
- Title of grant request
- Purpose and description and expected results
- Community that will be served
- Amount requested (up to \$10,000)
- How you will track effectiveness and report results
